Research Assistant (m/f/d) (Doctoral student)

The third party funded position is offered for a period of 3 years, if no former times of qualification must be considered. The starting date is as soon as possible. The position is part-time (65 % of regular working hours) with salary and benefits commensurate with a public service position in the state Hesse, Germany (TV-H E 13, 65 %).

The duties include scientific services in research and teaching, in particular the collaboration in the DFG-funded CRC 1021 project "RNA viruses induce heterologous immune protection from atopy and asthma" in the research division of the institute. More specifically, the doctoral student will work on virus infection-, peptide immunisation-, influenza vaccination- and allergen-induced experimental asthma- mouse models, as well as deep immunophenotyping using CyTOF, RNAseq analysis and flow cytometry.

The position is limited to a time period deemed adequate for the completion of a doctoral degree. As part of the assigned duties, there will be ample opportunity to conduct the independent scientific research necessary for the completion of a doctorate. The limitation complies to § 2, 1 WissZeitVG.

The successful applicant will hold a Diploma, a MSc-degree or equivalent in natural sciences with experiences in immunology/virology, cell and/or molecular biological methods and, ideally, expertise in animal experiments. Disposition to own scientific qualification in biology or biomedicine is expected.
